Directives for the Establishment of Fu Ssu-Nien Memorial Chair Professorship

October 08, 2013 Passed by the 2,781st Administrative Meeting

February 19, 2019 Amended in accordance with a resolution issued by the 3,030th Administrative Meeting

- Article 1 National Taiwan University (NTU or "the University") formulates the NTU Directives for the Establishment of the Fu Ssu-Nien Memorial Chair Professorship ("the Directives") in accordance with Article 9 of the University's Regulations for the Establishment of Chair Professorships to recruit domestic and international scholars with outstanding academic achievements and improve the academic standards of NTU.
- Article 2 The Fu Ssu-Nien Memorial Chair Professorship ("the Chair Professorship") is endowed by the China Foundation for the Promotion of Education and Culture to award the Chair Professorship to one professor at the University every year. The recipient of the Chair Professorship shall receive a one-time grant ("the Grant") of US\$20,000 and may retain the title for one year.
- Article 3 Recipients of the Chair Professorship shall be full-time professors at the University with outstanding academic achievements and at least 10 years of research/teaching experience in the field of humanities and social sciences OR internationally renowned scholars recently appointed to the University who have served in a research/teaching position at the University for at least one year.
- Article 4 The University shall establish a Chair Professorship Review Committee ("the Committee") to review nominations for Chair Professor appointments. The Committee shall be composed of a number of members appointed by the NTU President, with one executive vice president serving as convener.
- Article 5 The procedures for nominating the Chair Professor and awarding the Grant shall be as follows: Candidates may be nominated by the NTU President directly or by a nominating unit with the approval of the college-level (or equivalent) review committee. The Committee shall review the list of candidates and select the final recipients, whose names shall then be referred to the NTU President for appointment and to the China Foundation for the Promotion of Education and Culture for reference.
- Article 6 Recipients of the Chair Professorship may be invited to serve as Chair Speaker for their respective college or the University once in the academic year in which the Chair Professorship is awarded, and shall not be nominated for the Chair Professorship in three years.
- Article 7 Matters not addressed herein shall be subject to the University's *Regulations* for the Establishment of Chair Professorship.
- Article 8 The Directives shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
